John 8 ²⁸ Then Jesus said to them, "When you lift up the Son of Man (Όταν ὑψώσητε τὸν υἱὸν τοῦ ἀνθρώπου), then you will know that I am (ἐγώ εἰμι), and I do nothing of myself; but as My Father taught me, I speak these things.

John 8 23 And He said to them, "You are from beneath; I am from above. You are of this world; I am not of this world. 24 Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for if you do not believe that I am (ἐὰν γὰρ μὴ πιστεύσητε ὅτι ἐγώ εἰμι), you will die in your sins."

John 3 13 No one has ascended to heaven but He who came down from heaven, the Son of Man (mss **P**66 **P**75 **X** B L)

John 8 ⁵⁶ Your father Abraham rejoiced (ἦγαλλιάσατο) to see my day, and he saw it and was happy (ἐχάρη)." ⁵⁷ Then the Jews said to him, "You are not yet fifty years old, and have you seen Abraham?" ⁵⁸ Jesus said to them, "Amen, I say to you, before Abraham came to be, I am (πρὶν Ἀβραὰμ γενέσθαι ἐγὼ εἰμί)."

John 13 ¹⁹ From this point on, I tell you before it comes, that when it does come to pass, you may believe that I am (ἴνα πιστεύσητε ὅταν γένηται ὅτι ἐγώ εἰμι).
